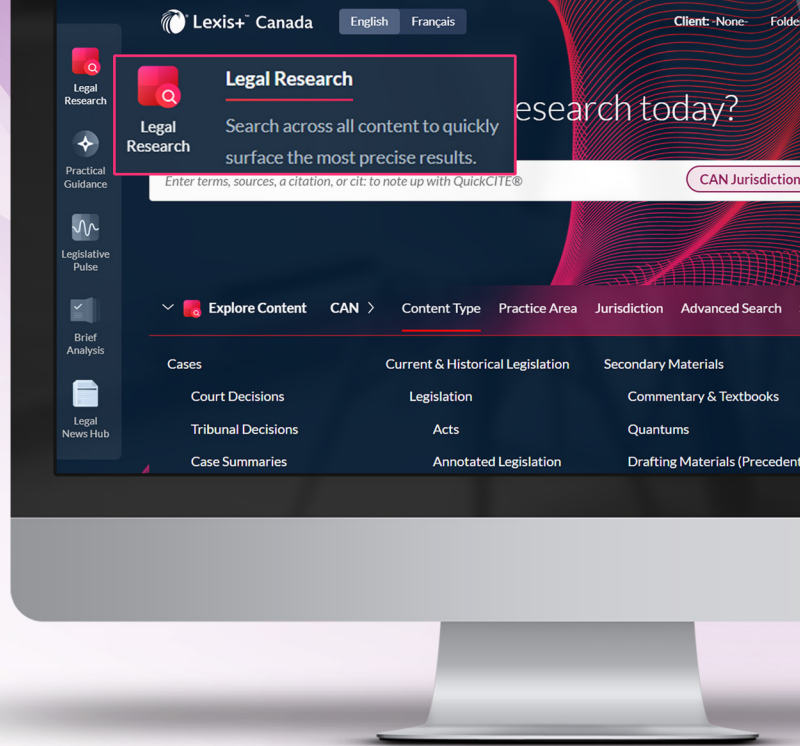


Succeeding in First Year with Lexis+™ Canada: Legal Research

Here's how to use these tools to master the essential legal research tasks expected of first-year law students:



TASK	LEXIS+ LEGAL RESEARCH TOOL
Find a specific decision, statute or regulation by name or citation and download/save a copy	Search bar, Advanced Search, Browse, Delivery Bar
Note up a specific decision or legislation with a full list of citing cases organized by treatment	Quickcite citator, Legislation citator
Locate where your search terms or quotes are referenced within citing decisions	graphical search term maps
Find the court filings from a specific case	Pleadings Motions and Facta
Add your own notes to legislation or case law documents and save for future reference	annotations, folders
Find legislation or caselaw within specific dates, jurisdictions or courts	Advanced Search, pre- and post-search filters
Conduct an exhaustive search for legislation or caselaw using keywords or terms and connectors	Search bar, Advanced Search
Explore expert-authored outlines of the leading cases and legislation on a wide range of legal topics, from the only complete Canadian legal encyclopedia with coverage of all 14 Canadian jurisdictions	Halsbury's Laws of Canada, Search or Browse
Access over one million summaries of Canadian court and tribunal decisions created by legally trained writers, dating back to 1870	case summaries
Track the precise steps of your legal research on a project	History, Folders
Answer a simple legal question, e.g. "what is [legal term]", by finding passages or quotations within caselaw that explain or define the concept	Lexis Answers
Find international, e.g. US, UK, case law	Country/Region in Search bar
Find and compare similar legislative provisions across Canadian jurisdictions	Tables of Concordance
